QUADRIO SHOPPING CENTRE VISITOR RULES

THE OWNER OF THE CENTRE OR HIS SECURITY SERVICE IS ENTITLED TO BAN ANYONE FROM ENTERING AND ORDER ANYONE VIOLATING THESE VISITOR RULES OUT OF THE PREMISES OF THE SHOPPING CENTRE AND THE ADJACENT PLOTS OF LAND.

The "CENTRE" shall mean Building No. 2121 which forms a part of the „QUADRIO" premises, including the relating plots, communications, infrastructure, equipment and areas of greenery in the locality of Spálená, Purkyňova, Vladislavova and Charvátova Streets, Prague 1 – Nové Město, as these are currently demarcated on the plan contained in these Visitor Rules.

The following acts are considered to be a breach of the rules

1. Any and all acts contradicting the legal regulations or directives of the CR, Capital City of Prague, Municipality of Prague 1, requirements of any and all authorities and official bodies as well as the principles of morality.
2. Demanding money or other contributions or gifts, performing any business, organisational, promotional or other similar activities without the previous written consent of the Centre management.
3. Disrupting public order e.g. by loud and disturbing conduct, use of physical force, any and all defamatory expressions or gestures aimed against race, religion or ethnicity, conduct with a distinct sexual subtext or other acts, which may result in a disturbance, or which may offend other persons present, or disturb the peace and order in the Centre.
4. Unauthorised gathering of persons in the Centre.
5. Making video or other recordings of the Centre or any and all events taking place in the Centre without the previous written consent of the Centre management.
6. Impairing, damaging or destroying the property of the Centre or the property located in the premises of the Centre, in particular security and fire safety equipment. In the case of damage to or misuse of the equipment the perpetrator shall be required to pay financial compensation for returning the equipment to its original condition.
7. Entry by persons under 10 years of age not accompanied by an adult.
8. Running, riding on roller skates, on a skateboard, a scooter, a bicycle or any other equipment. With the permission of the security service it is possible to lead a bicycle through the common areas on the ground floor of the Centre.
9. Entry by drunken people or persons under the influence of narcotic or psychotropic substances. Consuming alcohol (with the exception of the internal or external areas of restaurants) or using or distributing narcotic or psychotropic substances anywhere in the Centre.
10. Bringing toxic, poisonous, contaminated, malodorous or dangerous substances into the Centre.
11. Entry by persons, who may be a nuisance to other visitors due to their insufficient, torn or dirty clothing, their odour, dirtiness, or those who show visible symptoms of an infectious disease etc.
12. Throwing away or dumping any items with the exception of placing them into litter bins. Rummaging through litter bins and taking things out of them.
13. Consuming food or beverages in the internal areas of the Centre, except in areas designated for such.
14. Smoking.
15. Lying, sleeping or sitting on railings or steps, on litter bins or other places which are not explicitly designated for this purpose in the Centre.
16. Sleeping on seating furniture located in the premises of the Centre and the toilets of the Centre.
17. Washing laundry or washing activities other than normal hand washing in toilets.
18. Bringing firearms or other weaponry into any and all areas of the Centre (does not apply to officers of law enforcement authorities, members of other state armed forces and persons armed under written permission from the Centre management).
19. Entering the internal areas of the Centre with pets, with the exception of guide dogs of blind persons, dogs on leashes with muzzles or pets carried in a container or held in arms. Nonetheless, the security staff of the Centre are authorised to order visitors with pets out of the internal areas of the Centre at any time for operational or safety reasons as well as at their own discretion.
20. Tying anything - pets, bicycles etc. in the entrance interspaces leading into the internal areas of the Centre or anywhere else in the Centre, with the exception of areas explicitly designated for such.
21. Sitting or lying on the terrace in front of the main entrance to the internal areas of the Centre. For safety and hygiene reasons the terrace is regularly washed applying wet cleaning and chemical agents.

Entry to the office premises of the Centre is limited solely to the staff of the office premises of the Centre and their visitors, who are bound to register at the reception desk. Entry to any other non-public parts of the Centre is permitted only after the previous consent of the Centre administration for the specifically indicated reasons. Consent to any such entry to the office premises or non-public parts of the Centre may be denied at any time and the person may be ordered out from the Centre, and is bound to leave the Centre.

Note. The Centre management reserves the right to amend or supplement the provisions of these Visitor Rules. The Centre premises are monitored by a security CCTV system registered with the Office for Personal Data Protection (OPDP) – Registration No. 00054979.
